This information has raised questions regarding the purported benefits of the project that we feel must be addressed prior to committing the state- and our constituents- to a long term contract.

We therefore request you postpone the commercial close of this contract, currently scheduled for June 25th, until our concerns can be adequately addressed. We would like to have a session with the elected officials in the Lake Norman area and representatives from the NCDOT to address our concerns. We look forward to working closing with the NCDOT on this important issue.


